## NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Rockaway, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, on September 24, 2020. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Community Center, 21-25 Union Street in the Borough on October 22, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. Title: ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$500,000 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF ROCKAWAY, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

Purpose: \$550,000 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the following bond ordinances of the Borough of Rockaway, in the County of Morris, New Jersey are no longer necessary for the various purposes for which the obligations previously were authorized and are reappropriated to provide for water main improvements, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.
